# INTRODUCTION

If you need to replace any portion of the upper part of your laptop: screen, webcam, etc. then you need to remove the screen frame first. This guide will show you how to do that.

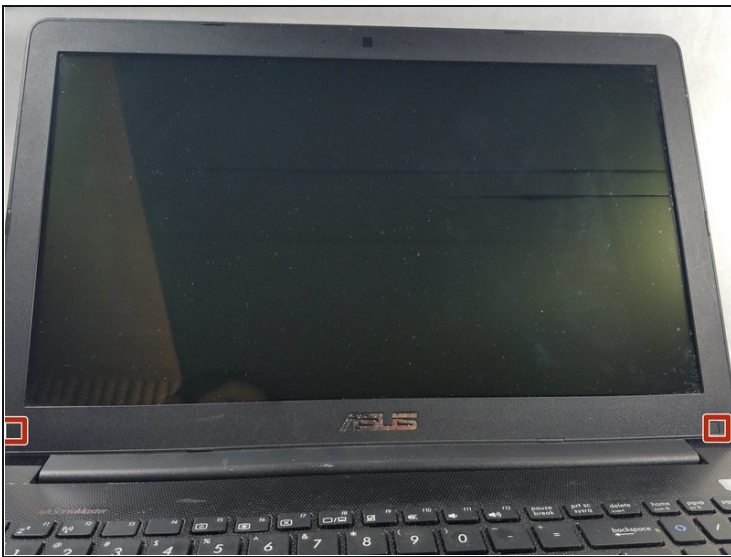

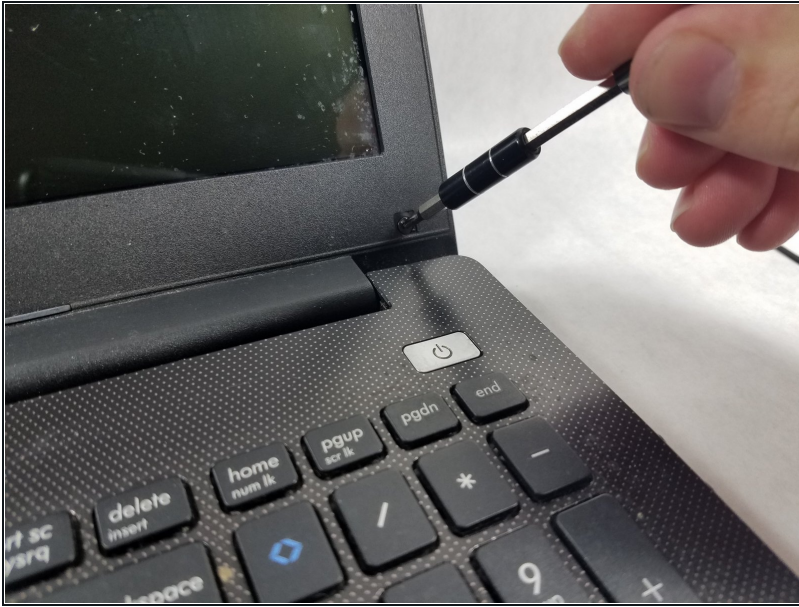

## Step 1 — Screen Frame



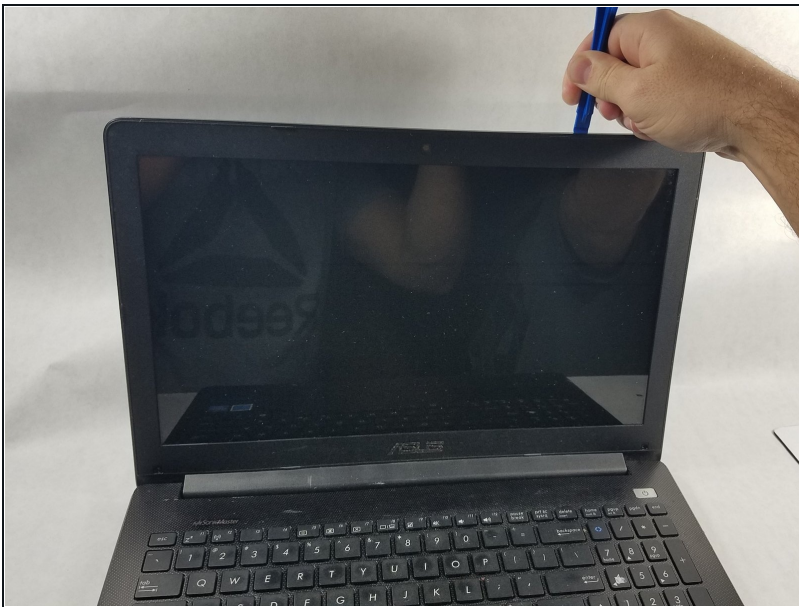
- Using the [tweezers](#), remove the 2 black plastic adhesive covers from the bottom corners of the screen frame.

## Step 2



- Use the Philips #00 screwdriver to remove the 2 screws that were revealed in the previous step.
- ① The screws are 20 mm in diameter and 50 mm long.

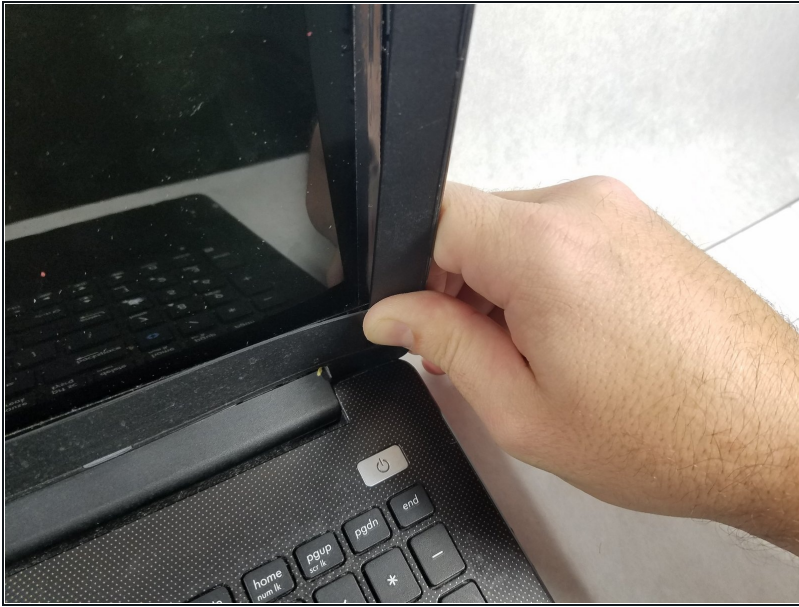
## Step 3



- Using the plastic opening tool, pry the screen frame away from the screen.



## Step 4



- Using your hands, grasp the screen frame at its base near the laptop hinge.
- While pulling the base of the screen frame away from the hinge horizontally, also lift up on the screen frame to disconnect it from the laptop hinge.

⚠ The space between the screen frame and laptop hinge is very small and the plastic for both parts is weak. However, a fair amount of force is required to disconnect the screen frame from the laptop hinge. Be careful during this step, or either of these plastic pieces may break.
