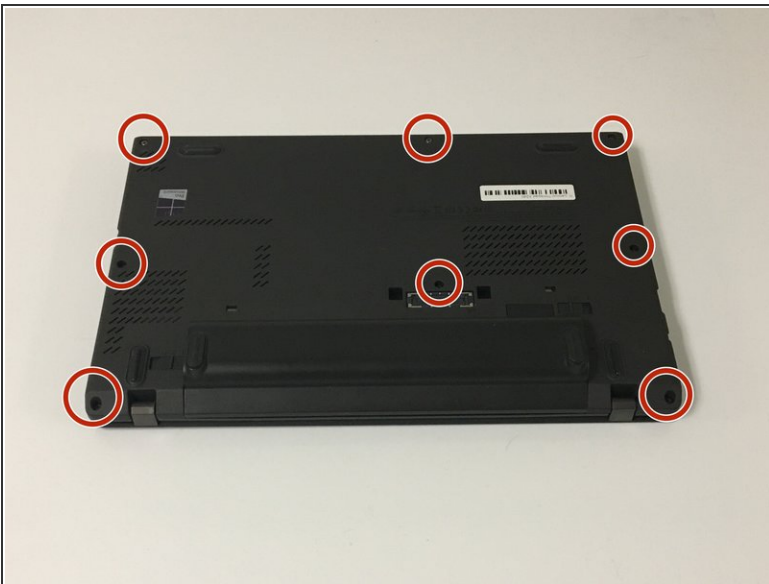

Step 1 — Hard Disk Drive and Solid State Drive



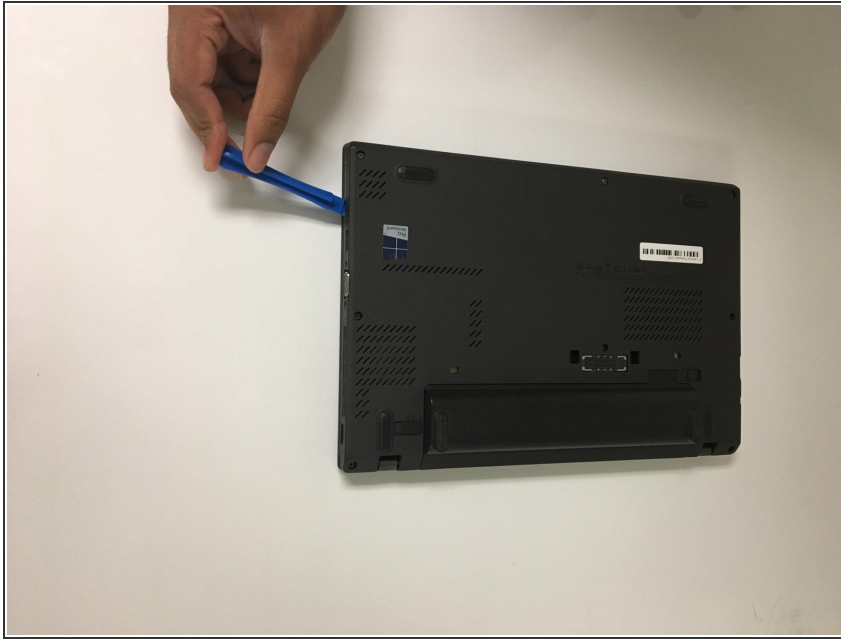
- Flip the laptop upside down as shown in the photo.

Step 2



- Remove the 8 0.2mm Phillips screws connecting the back cover to the laptop.

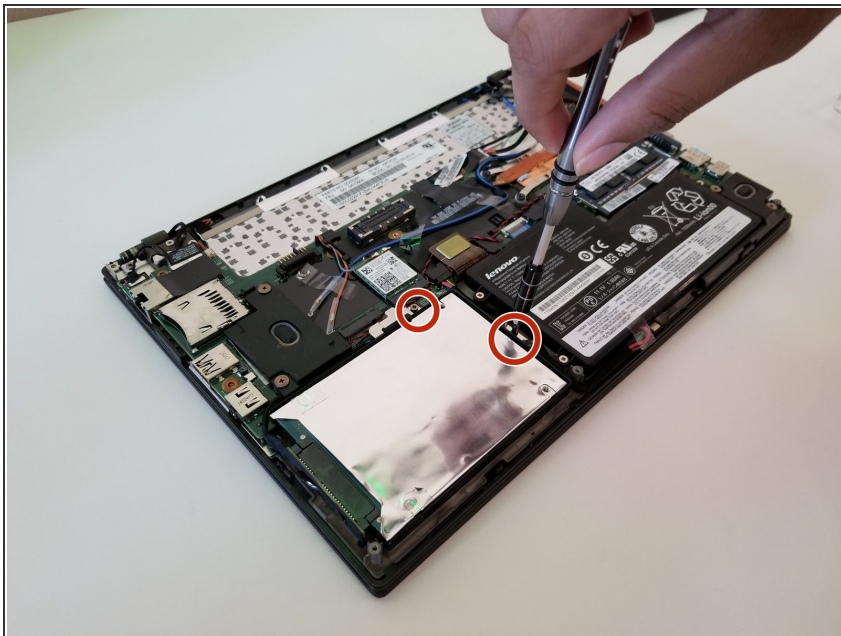
Step 3



- Remove the back cover using the opening tools.

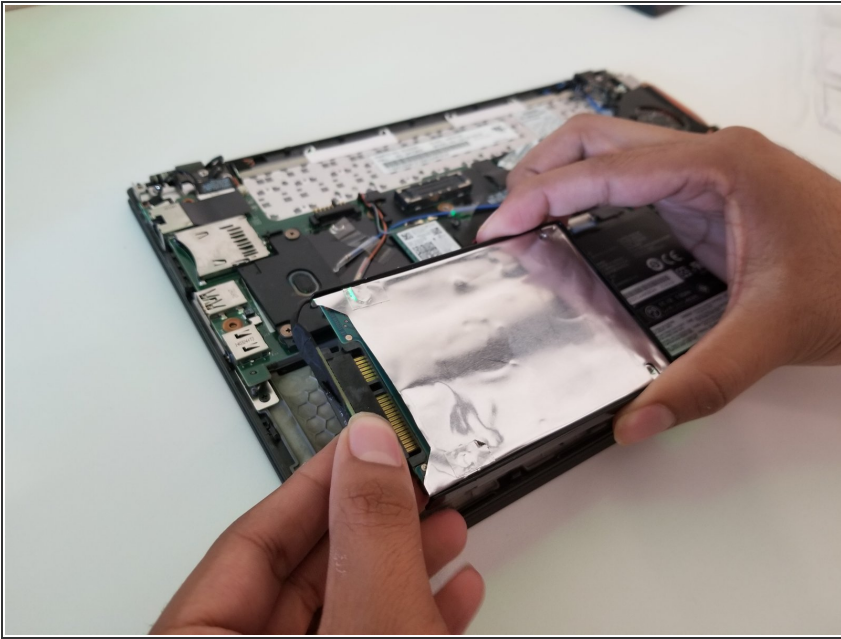
⚠ Gently use the plastic opening tools to prevent scratching your device.

Step 4



- Remove the Hard Disk Drive card by screwing the 2 0.2mm Phillips screw

Step 5



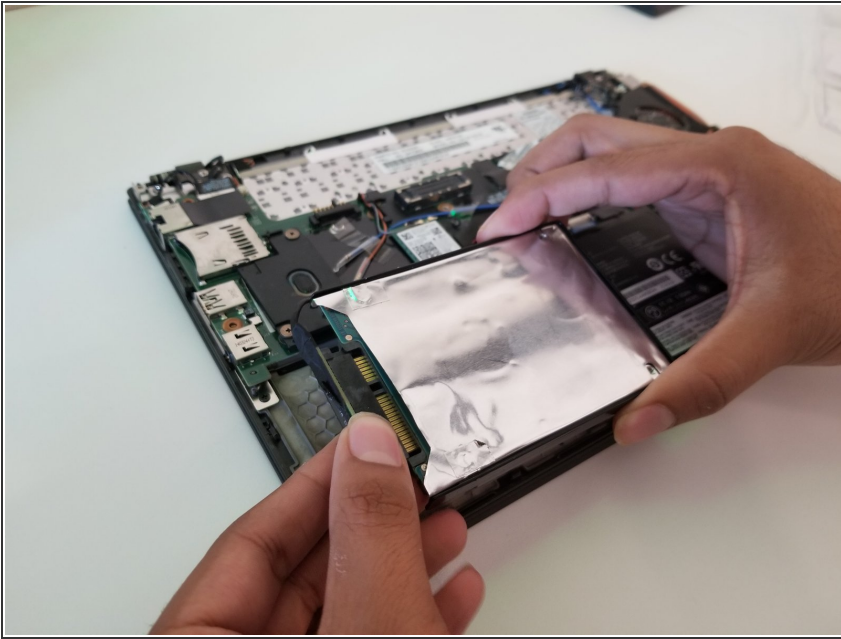
- Disconnect the SATA cable from the hard drive.

Step 6



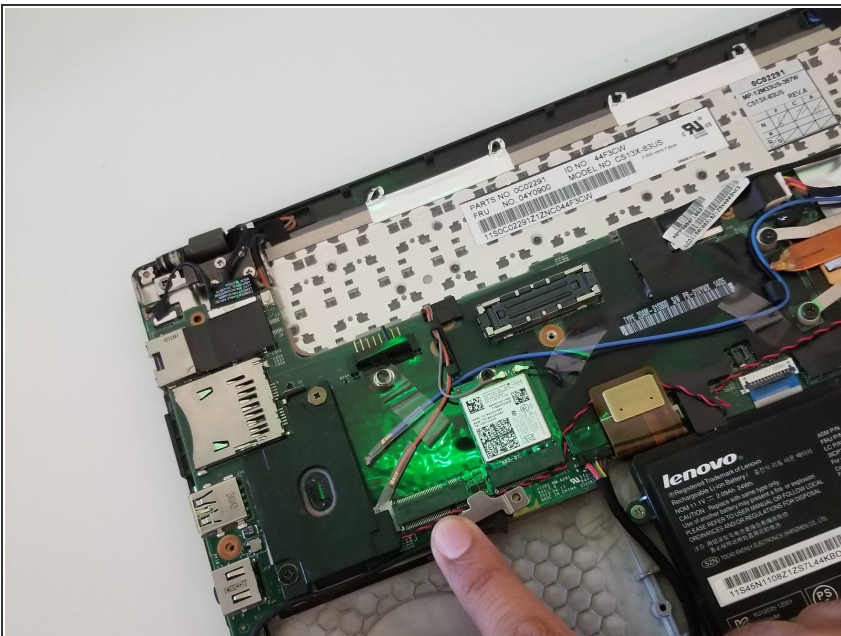
- Take off the connector by carefully popping its holders out of place

Step 7



- Reconnect the cable to the new Hard Disk Drive

Step 8



- place the connector in order to hold the cable

Step 9



- Place the new Hard Drive Disk

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
