


# Pioneer Elite PRO-RO6U Control Panel Circuit Board Replacement

Follow these steps to replace the control panel circuit board behind the front face of the Pioneer Elite Pro-R06U.

#### **INTRODUCTION**

A faulty or defective front control panel may cause buttons on the media receiver to be unresponsive. Replacing the circuit board should resolve issues with the front controls and buttons.



# **TOOLS:**


- Phillips #1 Screwdriver (1)
- iFixit Opening Tools (1)

## Step 1 — Control Panel Circuit Board




 Remove the two 6.4 mm Phillips screws on each side of the device's casing.

## Step 2




 Remove the two 6.5 mm Phillips screws on the back of the device casing.

### Step 3



 Grip the front panel in one hand and the back of the casing in the other.
 Pull the casing back, and slide it up and away from the inner box.

## Step 4




 Unlatch the three plastic connectors on the top of the receiver that hold the front panel to the device casing.

### Step 5




- The connectors on the bottom of the device may be very stiff and could require the use of a plastic prying tool.
  - Carefully flip the device over and unlatch the three plastic connectors that hold the front panel to the bottom of the device casing.

#### Step 6




 Grip and unplug the ribbon connector that connects the front circuit board to the device.

# Step 7



 Unscrew the three 1/4 Phillips head screws on the back of the front circuit board.

# Step 8





- Grip the circuit board and slide towards the front side of the plastic casing.
- Lift upwards to remove the circuit board from the front panel.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
