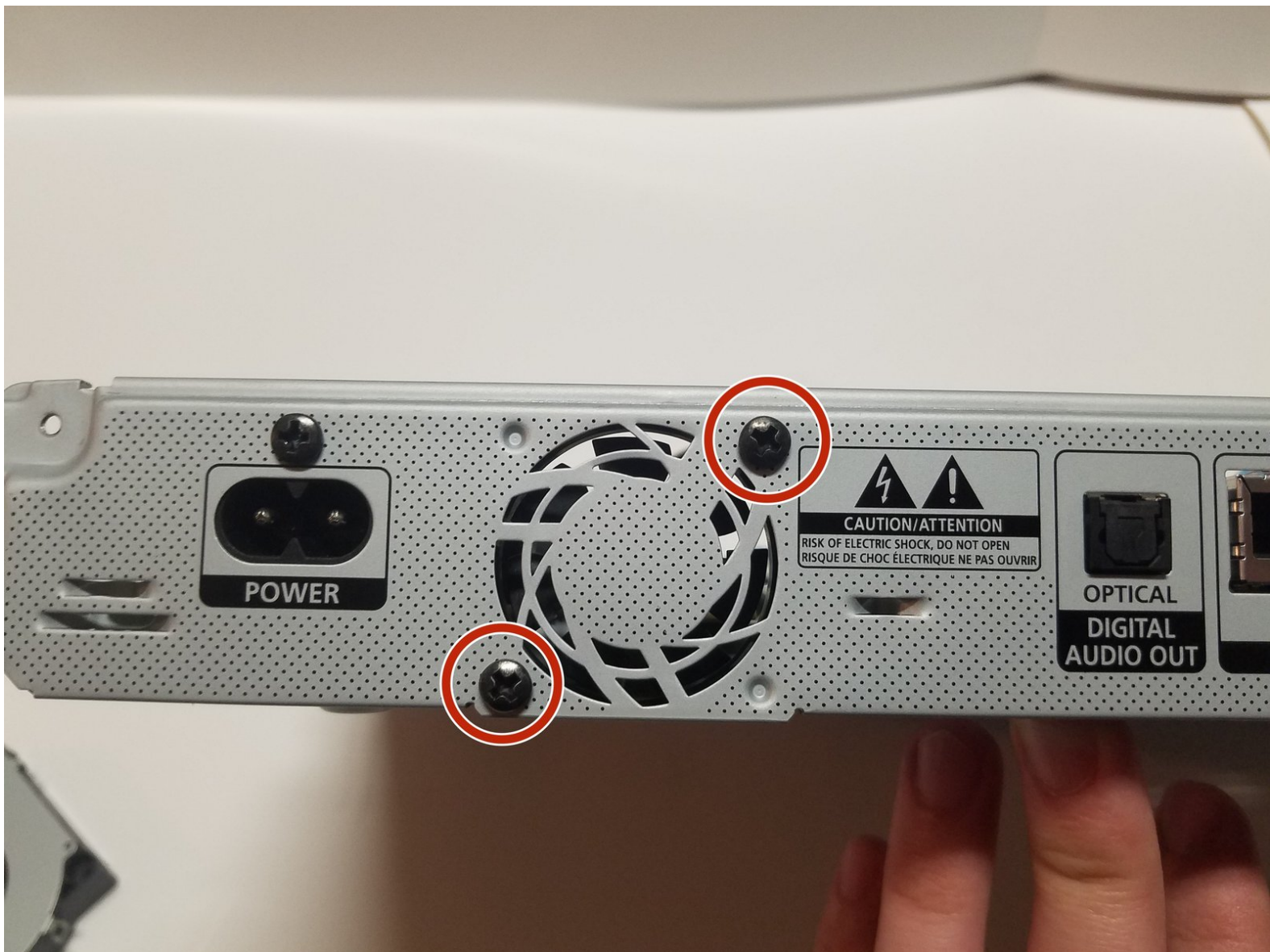




# Samsung UBD-KM85C Fan B Replacement

This guide is for replacing the side fan. This may be necessary if the device is overheating.

## INTRODUCTION

Use this guide to remove the side fan of your device.



### TOOLS:

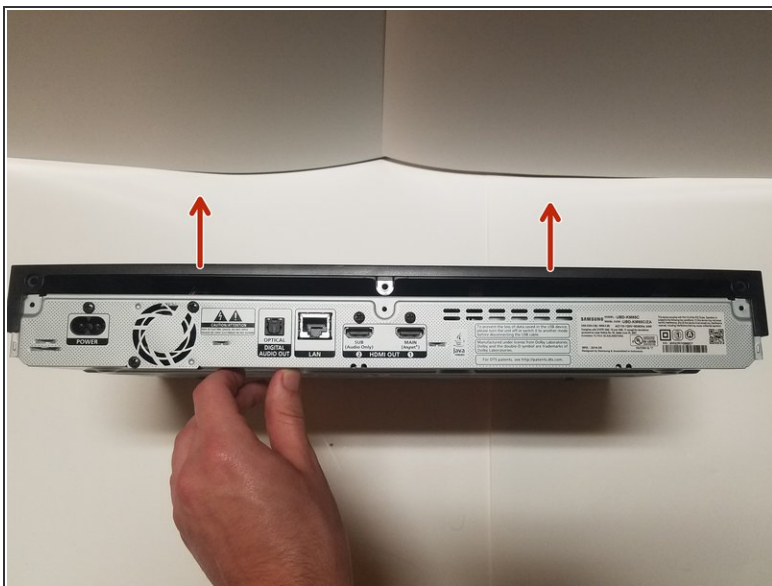
- [Phillips #1 Screwdriver](#) (1)

## Step 1 — Outer Shell



- On the back side of the unit, remove the three 8.1mm screws marked with a Phillips #1 screwdriver.

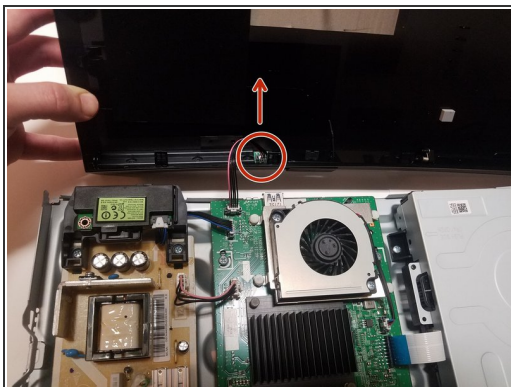
## Step 2



- From the back, lift the case upwards away from the unit then forwards, releasing the prongs on the front.



## Step 3



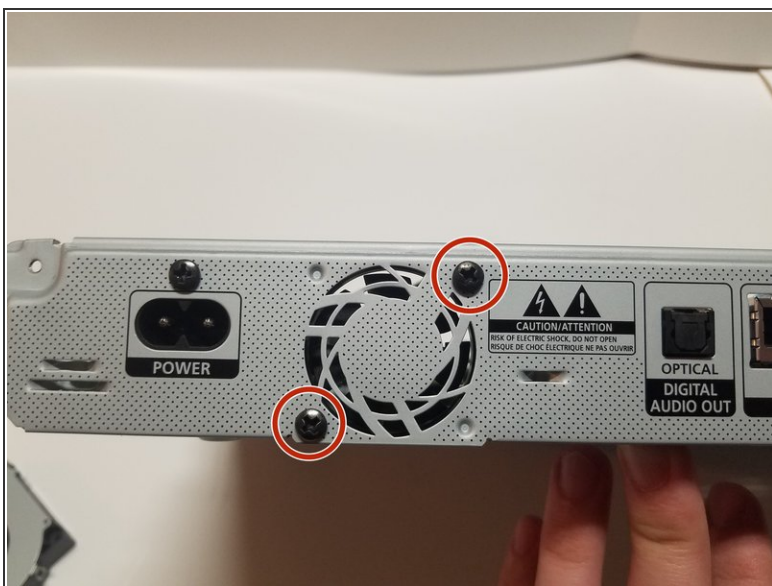
- There is one group of wires located towards the front of the case and attached directly to the motherboard and the case. Using two fingers in a pinching motion, release the wire from the clip and disconnect it.

## Step 4



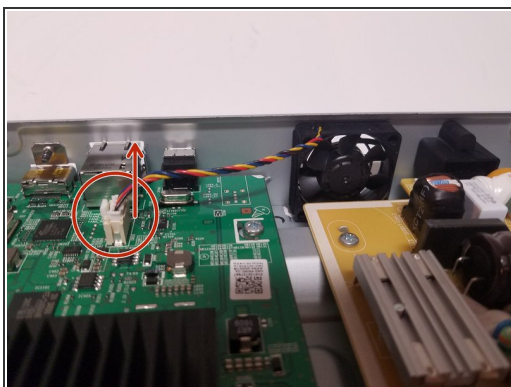
- Remove the cover from the device.

## Step 5 — Fan B



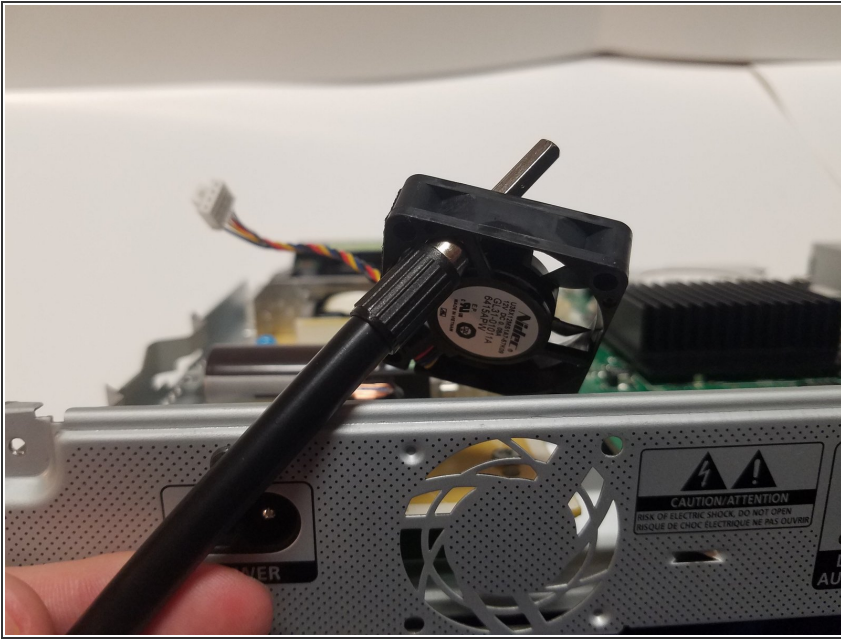
- Using a #1 phillips head screwdriver, remove the two 8.1 mm screws in the corners of the fan.

## Step 6



- Use your fingers to pinch the white tip of the multicolored wire connecting the fan to the motherboard. While pinching, gently pull up to remove the wires from the motherboard.

## Step 7



- The fan is now free from its screws and wire and can be freely lifted out of the casing.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
