TOOLS:


• Phillips #0 Screwdriver (1)

Step 1 — Sliding the Latches



 Slide the battery lock latches into the unlocked position.

Step 2 — Slide the Battery




 Slide the battery toward the back of the computer to remove.

Step 3 — Remove the Screws




 Remove the eight screws from the access panel.

Step 4 — Lifting the Access Panel




• Lift the edge of the access panel that is closest to the center of the computer.

Step 5 — Remove the Access Panel




Remove the access panel.

Step 6 — Removing the Memory Module




 If applicable, remove the top memory module by using your fingertips to carefully spread apart the securing clips on each end of the top memory module connector until the memory module pops up.

Step 7 — Sliding the Memory Module



 Slide the memory module out of the socket.

Step 8 — Spreading apart the Clips



 If applicable, remove the bottom memory module by using your fingertips to carefully spread apart the securing clips on each end of the memory module connector until the memory module pops up.

Step 9 — Sliding the Memory Module



 Slide the memory module out of the socket.
