### **INTRODUCTION**

This guide will show you how to remove and replace the track pad of your Asus Vivobook Max X541SA-PD0703X. There are no additional parts that you need to replace in order to access the track pad.



# **TOOLS:**

- iFixit Opening Tools (1)
- Phillips #0 Screwdriver (1)
- Tweezers (1)



### **PARTS:**

• Track Pad (1)

# Step 1 — Keyboard




 Flip the laptop upside down so that the back of the laptop faces you.

# Step 2



- Remove the following ten Phillips #0 screws from the bottom of the laptop:
  - Six 13mm screws.
  - Four 11mm screws.

### Step 3




- Using a plastic opening tool, pry up the palm rest form the bottom half of the laptop.
- (i) Ribbon cables connect the two half so don't remove completely.

# Step 4




- Use a spudger to flip up the retaining flap on the keyboard ribbon cable <u>ZIF</u> sockets.
- Pull the ribbon cables out of their sockets.

# Step 5




 Take the keyboard half of the laptop and place it in front of you so that they keys are facing down.

# Step 6



 Remove the three 3mm Phillips #0 screws from the touchpad.

## Step 7



- Use a spudger to flip up the retaining flap on the touch pad ribbon cable <u>ZIF</u> socket.
- Pull the ribbon out of the socket.

# Step 8





Remove the touchpad.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
