


# Lenovo ThinkPad S431 HDMI-USB Jack assembly Replacement

How to remove the HDMI-USB Jack assembly part from your Lenovo ThinkPad S431.

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#### **INTRODUCTION**

This guide will show you the steps to safely remove the HDMI-USB Jack assembly from the Lenovo ThinkPad S431. The HDMI-USB Jack assembly is used to transfer audio and visual data.



#### **TOOLS:**

- Phillips #000 Screwdriver (1)
- Phillips #0 Screwdriver (1)
- Phillips #1 Screwdriver (1)
- iFixit Opening Tools (1)



#### PARTS:

• 2.5" SATA Hard Drive (1)


## Step 1 — Hard Disk Drive






Remove the 8 screws that hold down the back panel using the Phillips #000 screwdriver.

# Step 2




Remove the two M2 x 3 mm, waferhead, nylon-coated screws that hold down the hard drive assembly using the Phillips #0 screwdriver.




 Pull the hard drive assembly out with backside up.

# Step 4



 Remove the four M3 x 3 mm, flathead, nylon-coated screws on the side of the hard drive assembly using the Phillips #0 screwdriver.




 Gently, remove the plastic cover with the blue strips.


## Step 6 — HDMI-USB Jack assembly





- Remove the 3 screws holding down the T shaped cover using the Phillips head #1. Two of the screws are M2.5x 4 wafer head. The other is a M2x4MM.
- i The two similar screws have blue threading around them.





- Use the opening tool to lift up the T shaped cover.
- Remove the M2x3MM wafer head screw.


# Step 8







- Take off the 2 M2x3MM wafered screws holding down the chip top of assembly.
- Lift the chip to release the HDMI-USB jack assembly



Detach the connector.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
