
INTRODUCTION

In the steps shown below, you will easily be able to replace the SIM Card in the phone with a new (or old) SIM Card. This can happen due to a change of service providers or a new service plan.

Step 1 — Battery



- Locate the indent area highlighted in red and use either your fingernail or a Prying Tool (such as a guitar pick) to separate the back from the body of the phone.

Step 2



- Once the cover is removed, locate the battery that reads "SAMSUNG."
- Use either your fingernail or a Plastic Prying Tool (such as a guitar pick) to lift up the bottom indent of the battery.

⚠ Do not use a metal tool, as it can cause injury.

Step 3 — SIM Card



- Use a finger nail, guitar pick, or a plastic tool such as the one shown to slide out the SIM Card to the right.

⚠ Do not use metal tool as it can cause damage to SIM Card or internal parts of phone.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
