INTRODUCTION

This guide can be used to remove or replace the pedals of a Trek 820 cycling bike.

Pedals are the least serviced parts of a bike, and it can become a problem when shock bushing and bearings are worn out. It can lead to reduced performance, difficulty in pedaling smoothly, and potential safety issues.

If pedals develop unusual noises or fail to release from cleats properly, replacing them becomes important. It ensures a safer and more efficient cycling experience.

TOOLS:

7/16" Wrench (1)

Step 1 — Pedals



- Unscrew pedals with a 7/16" wrench until it comes off.
 - ① Unscrew the left pedal clockwise and the right pedal counter-clockwise.

Step 2



- Replace the old pedal with the new one.
- ① Screw in the left pedal counter-clockwise and the right pedal clockwise.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
