

Giant Reign 2 Front Wheel Replacement

This guide demonstrates how to remove the front wheel from the fork of the bike.

INTRODUCTION

Removing the front wheel of the Giant Reign 2 is a common first step for other repair guides. This guide will clearly show you how to use simple tools to remove the front wheel quickly and safely.

TOOLS:

- 4mm Allen Wrench (1)
- 8 mm Allen Wrench (1)

Step 1 — Hex Screws



 Using the 4mm Allen wrench, partially unscrew the 4 (22mm) hex screws on the front of the axle casing to allow the axle to slide freely.

Step 2 — Axle Screw



- Using the 8mm Allen wrench, loosen the axle screw until 1/2 of the axle screw is visible.
- Push the axle screw to reveal the axle rod on the other side.

Step 3



- Using the Allen wrench, finish unscrewing the axle screw and pull it out.
- Hold the wheel when pulling out the axle rod so that the bike does not fall.

Step 4 — Front Wheel



• Pull the wheel from the fork.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
