INTRODUCTION

Make sure to disconnect the battery before replacing the hard drive.

TOOLS:

TR8 Torx Security Screwdriver (1)
Phillips #1 Screwdriver (1)
iFixit Opening Tool (1)

Step 1 — Battery



- ⚠ Turn off laptop before beginning.
- Place the laptop upside down on a flat, stable surface.






• Remove the 3mm screw in the location shown, using a Phillips #1 screwdriver.

Step 3




 Remove the panel from the sides and pull it out at an angle towards you.



• Remove the five 3mm screws on the battery with a Torx (T8) screwdriver in the locations shown.

Step 5




- Disconnect the power cord from the battery by using a pair of <u>tweezers</u>, your fingers, or the opening tools from the iFixit pro tech tool kit.
- Pinch the clips on the left and right side while pulling on the cord at the same time.



- Pull the battery towards you.
- Make sure to pull at an upward angle.

Step 7 — Hard Drive




• Remove the four 5mm screws with a Phillips #1 screwdriver.



- Remove the cable from the motherboard that is attached to the Hard Drive.
- Use your fingers or the plastic opening tools to gently pull up on the clip, freeing the cable.

Step 9



• Lift and remove Hard Drive.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
