


ZTE ZFive G LTE Front-Facing Camera Replacement

INTRODUCTION

This guide provides the steps necessary to replace the front-facing camera on the ZTE ZFive G LTE.



TOOLS:

- iFixit Opening Tools (1)
- Tweezers (1)
- JIS #000 Screwdriver (1)

Step 1 — Front-Facing Camera







Using the opening tool, pry open the rear cover from the crease at the bottom left corner.

Step 2







Remove the battery with an opening tool or fingernail.

Step 3



- Unscrew all 16 screws from the midframe J000 screwdriver.
- (i) Set the screws aside.

Step 4






- Gently pull up the device body from the inside.
- (i) Make sure to pull on all four sides as shown here.


Step 5





- Once the body is removed, you will see the front facing camera at the top right corner of the device.
- Using an opening tool, lift up the protective clip on top of the camera's ribbon wire.

Step 6





- Using angled tweezers, gently pull the ribbon wire up from the body.
- (i) With the ribbon wire out, you should be able to remove the camera.
- ↑ If there is adhesive on the camera backing, it may require more force to pull the camera out.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
