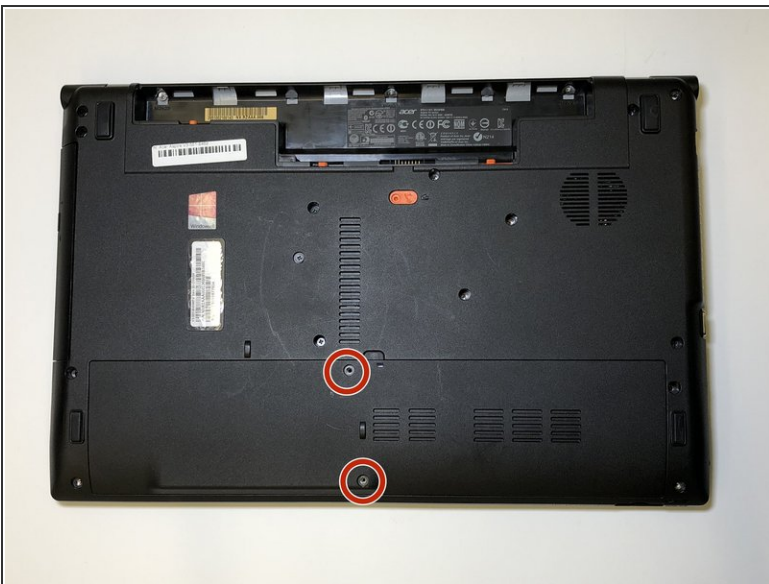

Step 1 — RAM



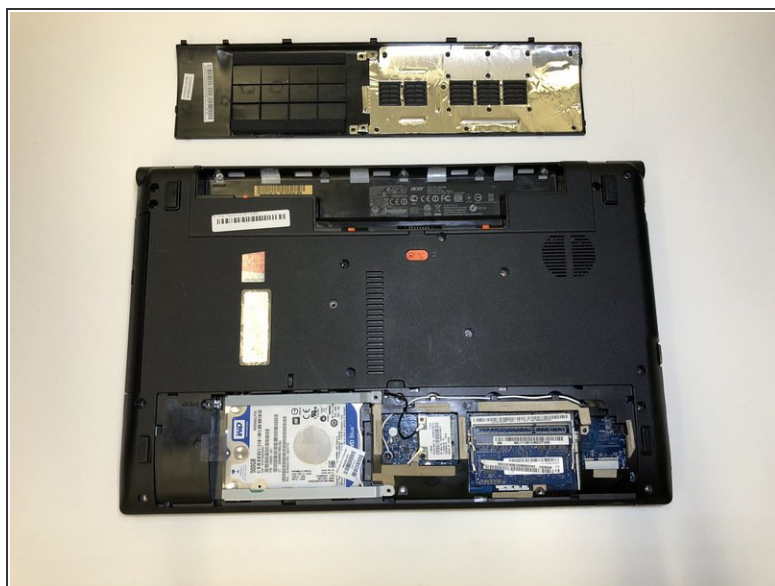
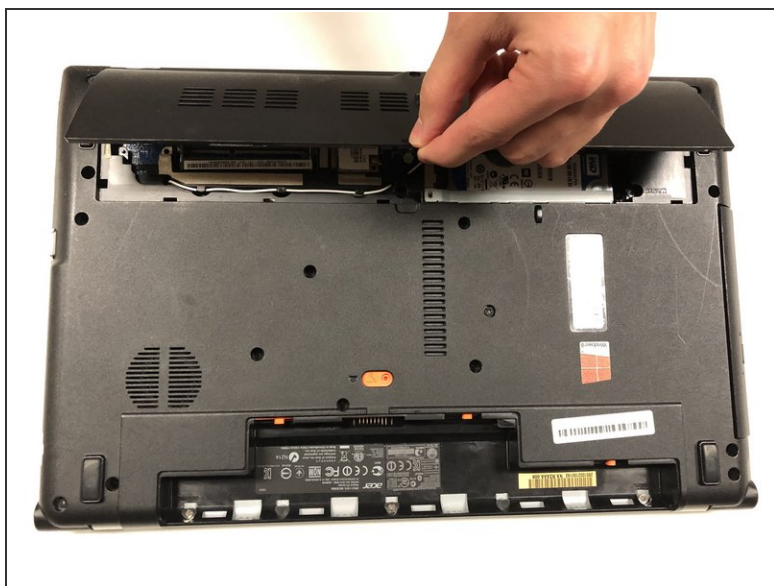
- To release the battery, slide the orange tab to the right with a spudger.
- The battery is now released and can be picked up and set to the side.

Step 2



- Remove the two 5.3 mm Phillips #0 screws.

Step 3



- Pull off the back panel.

Step 4



- Use two plastic opening tools to pry the two clips outward to release the RAM chip.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
