INTRODUCTION

This guide shall detail and illustrate how to replace the home button for a Samsung Galaxy Y in the situation of the home button not being responsive or broken.



TOOLS:

- Tweezers (1)
- Metal Spudger (1)
- iFixit Opening Tools (1)
- Phillips #000 Screwdriver (1)



PARTS:

Samsung Galaxy Y Home Button (1)

Step 1 — Back Panel








• Use the blue plastic opening tool to pry the back-panel off of the device.

Step 2 — **Touch Screen/Display**







- Use the screwdriver with a Phillips #000 screwdriver head to remove the four 5mm screws located in the corner of the interior back panel.
- Remove the SD card as well by sliding the card out of it's slot.

Step 3







• Use the metal pry tool to separate the interior back panel from the interior hardware and screen.

⚠ Using a metal spudger may cause further damage to your device.

Step 4







 Disconnect the orange motherboard connection, then remove the interior hardware from the front screen display.

Step 5 — Home Button





Remove the Home Button from the device.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
