INTRODUCTION

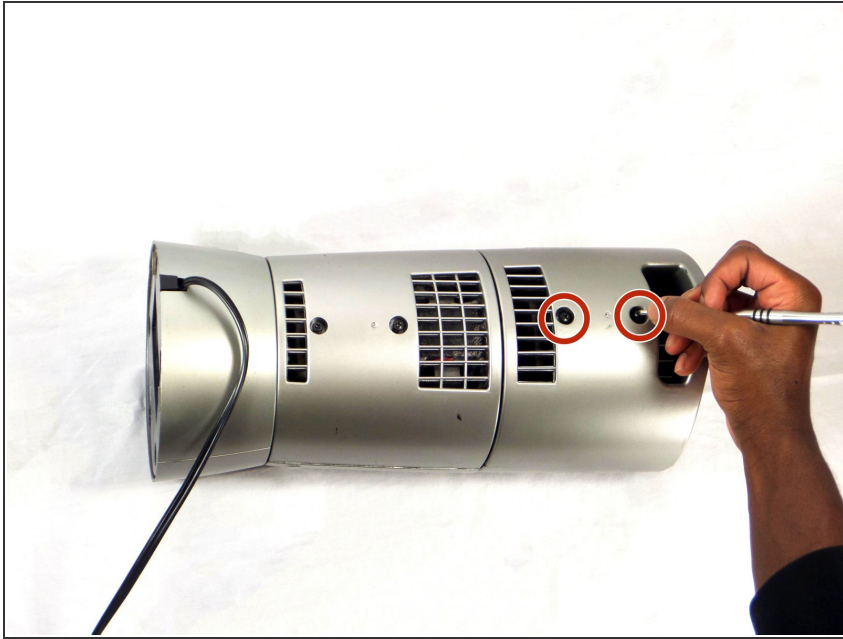
If the filter in the fan is dirty and needs to be replaced, use this guide to learn how to disassemble the top part of the fan and replace your filter.



TOOLS:

- [Phillips #0 Screwdriver](#) (1)

Step 1 — Filter



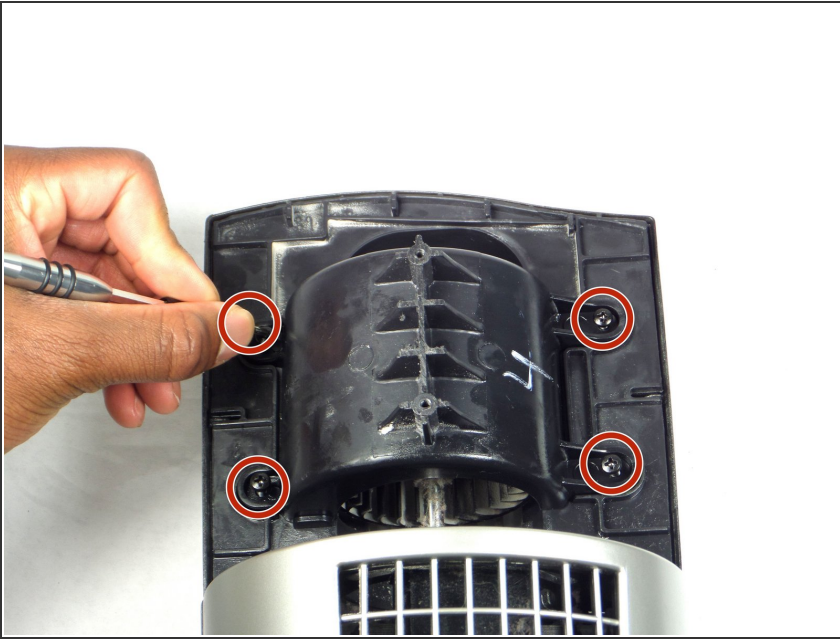
- On the backside of the fan, remove the top two 4mm Phillips #Y1 screws using PH 1 bit and Magnetic Driver

Step 2



- Remove the top plastic portion of the fan

Step 3



- Remove all four 4mm screws using the Phillips #1 screwdriver.

Step 4



- Remove the filter from the fan.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
