


Droid Ultra XT1080 Charging Port Replacement

How to replace a Motorola Droid Ultra charging port.

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INTRODUCTION


This guide will teach you how to replace the charging port of your device.



TOOLS:

- iFixit Opening Tools (1)
- Spudger (1)
- T5 Torx Screwdriver (1)
- T4 Torx Screwdriver (1)
- Soldering Iron (1)

Step 1 — Charging Port




 Remove SIM card tray from the device with a plastic opening tool.

Step 2



- Once SIM card tray is removed press the spudger between the plastic case and the frame of the device until you hear a snap.
- Work your away around the device until all the plastic clips are undone.
- Be gentle with the plastic to make sure it doesn't break.

Step 3



- Remove the five screws on top of the device with a T5 Torx.
- Remove the single screw holding the camera with a T4 Torx.
- Remove the two screws on the bottom of the device with a T5 Torx.


Step 4






 Once the screws are removed, use a plastic spudger and lift up the two plastic pieces that were secured by the screws.

Step 5



 Remove the four T5 Torx screws securing the motherboard.


Step 6



 Gently pry the motherboard out of the frame of the device.


Step 7





Once the motherboard is free flip it over on its back so all the components are showing.

Step 8



 To fully replace the charging port you need to desolder the port and solder a new one in.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
