

Acer TravelMate P653-V-6882 Keyboard Replacement

Keyboard replacement guide for the Acer TravelMate P653-V-6882.

INTRODUCTION

If your Acer TravelMate P653-V-6882's keyboard is still not responding after restarting the device and/or updating the keyboard drivers, then your keyboard may need to be replaced or reconnected.

Here is the guide on how to replace the TravelMate's keyboard.



TOOLS:

- iFixit Opening Tools (1)
- Phillips #1 Screwdriver (1)
- Spudger (1)

Step 1 — Battery Pack





- Turn the computer over so the base is facing up.
- Slide the battery lock to unlock position.

Step 2




- Slide the battery release latch to the right.
- (i) The battery pack will pop out.

Step 3




- Lift the battery up.
- Pull out the battery.

Step 4 — Base Door



 Remove the five 7mm Phillips #1 screws.

Step 5



- Use the opening tool to separate base door from the bottom of the laptop.
 - Be careful not to bend or crack the plastic back cover.

Step 6





- Gently pry open the base door by pushing up.
- Pull out the base door.
- A Be careful not to bend or crack the plastic back cover.

Step 7 — Keyboard



 Remove the two 7mm Phillips #1 screws.

Step 8



- Flip the laptop so that the underside is now facing the bottom.
- Open the LCD panel.
- Use the flat end of a spudger to push in the six latches.
- ⚠ Be careful not to bend or crack the keyboard.

Step 9



- When the latches are pushed in, the keyboard will pop out.
- Gently pry up the keyboard.
- Be careful not to bend or crack the keyboard.

Step 10



- Slide the keyboard forward to access the keyboard cable.
- Flip the connector latch up to open it.
- Pull out the keyboard cable gently.
- Be careful not to damage the connector.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
