


# **Bear 1000 Filter Replacement**

## **INTRODUCTION**

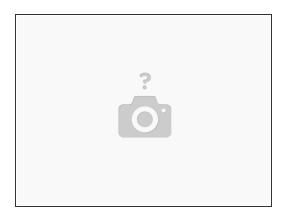
This guide will walk you through the process of replacing the ambient air intake filters in a Bear 1000 Ventilator. Found on page 97 in the full service manual.



# **TOOLS:**


• Flathead Screwdriver (1)

#### Step 1 — Filter




• Turn off the ventilator and disconnect from AC power and pressurized gas at the wall sources.

# Step 2




 Open the ventilator by removing the console retaining screw.

## Step 3



 Vacuum all surfaces inside the ventilator. Be sure to reach areas around connectors, circuit boards and pneumatic assembles.

## Step 4



Remove old filters in back panel and replace with new ones.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
