This guide will show you how to replace the back panel of your TomTom XXL 540.

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
INTRODUCTION

This guide shows how to replace the back panel on a TomTom XXL 540.

TOOLS:

- T5 Torx Screwdriver (1)
- Tweezers (1)
- Flathead Screwdriver (1)

Step 1 — Remove the screws



- Using tweezers, peel back the sticker on the bottom of the device to reveal the two T5 screws.
- Use the T5 Torx screwdriver to unscrew the two T5 screws.



Step 2 — Remove the faceplate

• Use a flat edge screwdriver to pry open the faceplate.

Step 3 — Remove the ribbon cable




• Release the ribbon cable that connects the two sides.

Step 4 — Remove the screws from the motherboard



- Identify the green motherboard.
- Use the T5 Torx screwdriver to unscrew the three T5 screws that hold the motherboard in place.

Step 5 — Remove the board and battery



 Remove and disconnect the motherboard and battery from the back panel.

Step 6 — Re-attach the board and battery



• Attach the motherboard and battery to the new back panel.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
