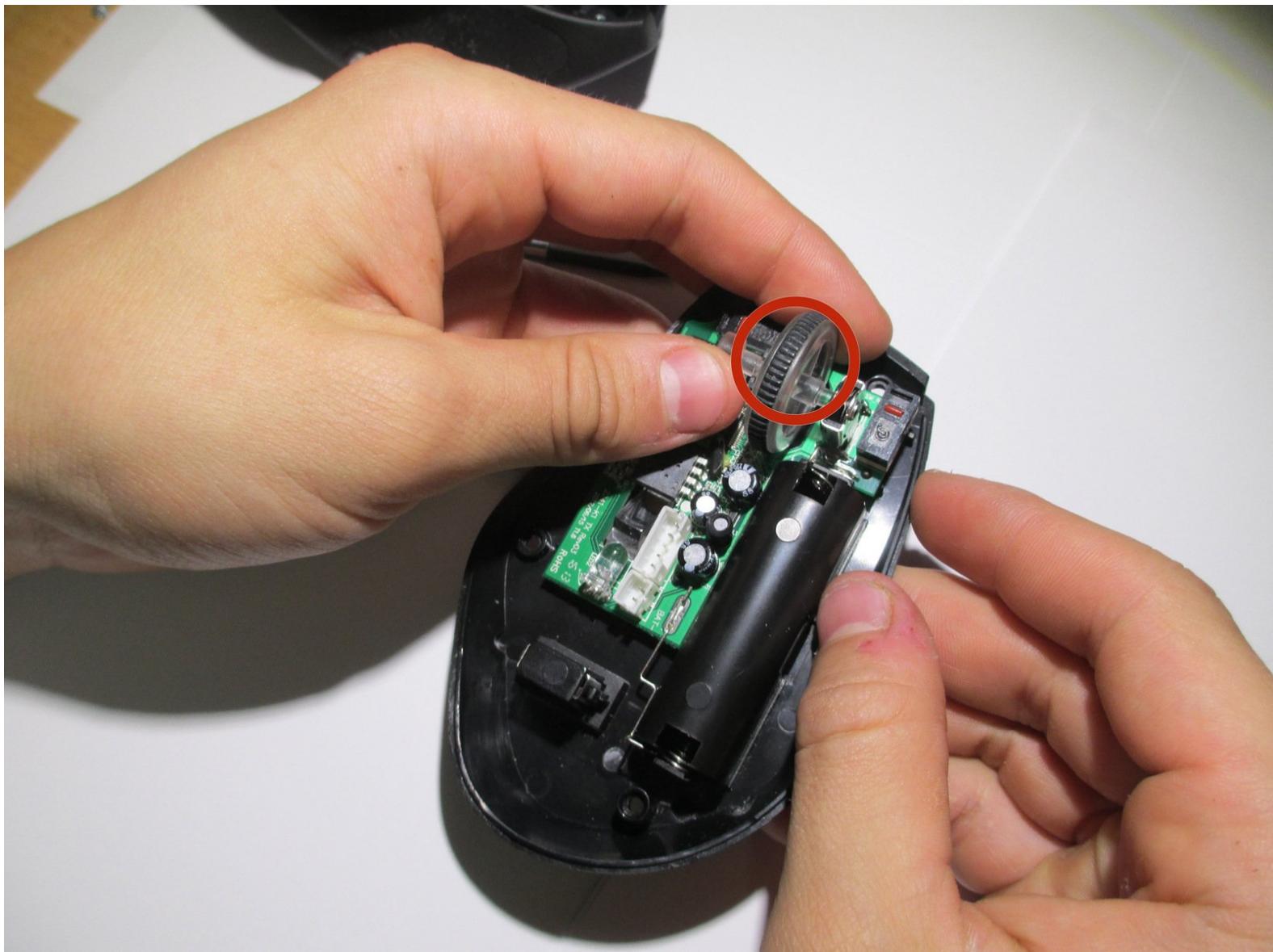

# INTRODUCTION

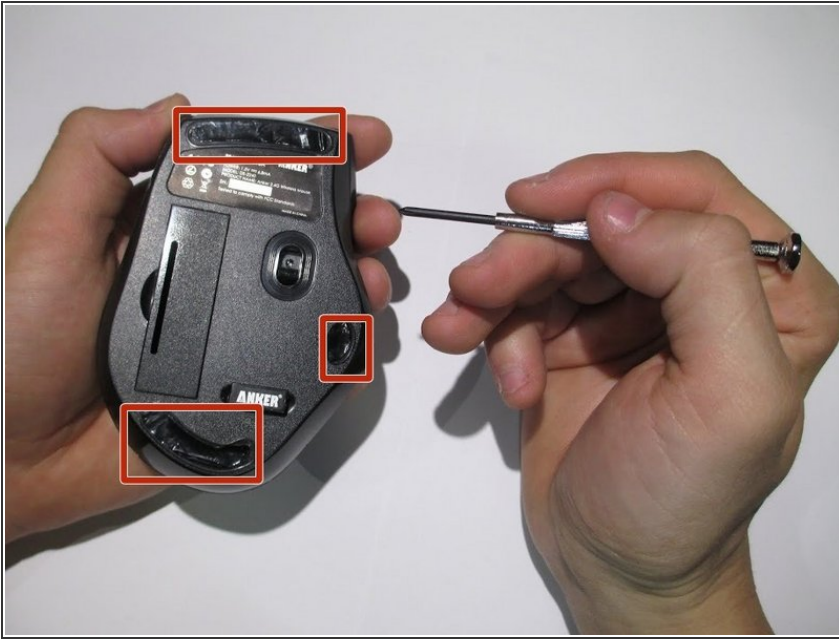
## TOOLS:

## Step 1 — How to Clean the Anker 2.4G Wireless Mouse Scroll Wheel



- Use a Phillips #0 screwdriver to remove the stickers that are hiding the screws.
- ⓘ The sticker may or may not stick back on the mouse after you complete the cleaning. You may want to use some clear tape to replace the stickers.

## Step 2



- Remove four screws using a Phillips #0 screwdriver.



### Step 3



- Use a spudger to pry along the center seam of the mouse.
- Open the outer casing of the mouse.

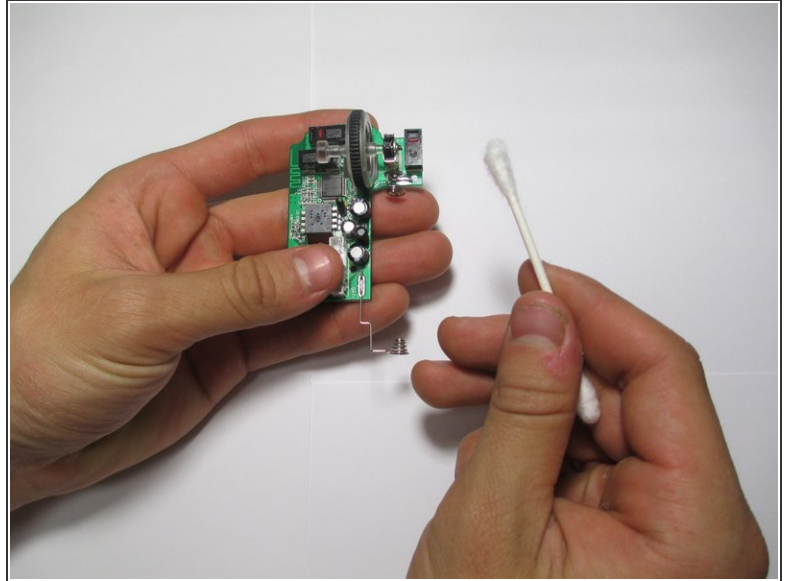
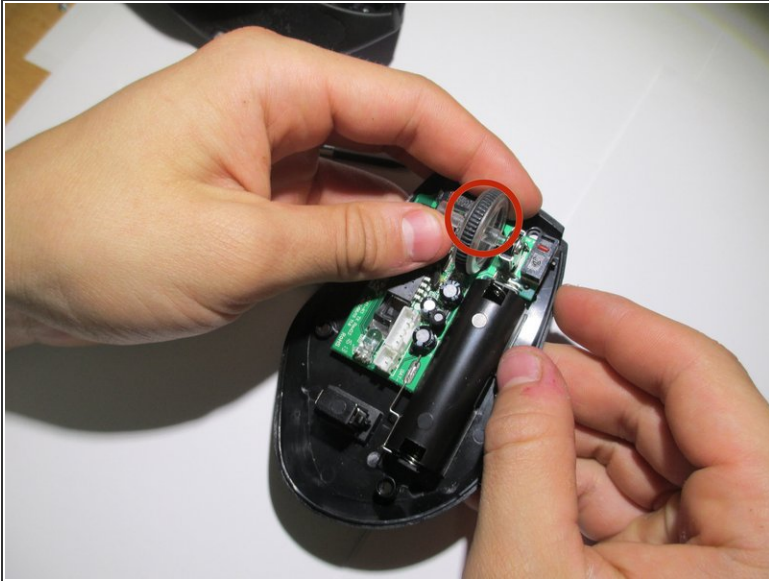
### Step 4



- Remove the wires from the white crimp headers in order to separate the upper and lower housing units of the mouse.

**⚠ Pull the wires as gently as possible to ensure that the wires will not break.**

## Step 5



- Take a cotton swab and lightly remove any dirt or debris around the pin connections of the scroll wheel.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
