INTRODUCTION

How to replace the LCD screen if it is broken or cracked.



TOOLS:

• Phillips #1 Screwdriver (1)

Step 1 — Battery





- Place your thumb on the battery cover and push left towards the arrow.
- (i) The cover will release and pop open.

Step 2



Remove the batteries from the camera.

Step 3 — Casing



- Remove four 3 mm screws on the right side of the camera using a Phillips #1 screwdriver.
- i This will release the front and back casings.

Step 4



- Use your nail or a flat object to pry up the edge of the front casing. Push the casing up and back.
- (i) Repeat this step for the back casing.

Step 5 — LCD Screen



 Under the screen, locate the black plastic strip that sits above the white plastic strip.

Step 6



- Pull both sides of the black piece upward-about a mm.
- The black plastic piece is not meant to come all the way off, just enough to release the screen.
- Once the piece is lifted carefully slide the screen out of the slot.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
