




TOOLS:

- iFixit Opening Tools (1)
- Spudger (1)
- Phillips #0 Screwdriver (1)

Step 1 — Back Cover







- Switch-off the tablet.
- Remove any SIM and/or Memory Card.
- Start opening near to the Volume Up/Down buttons. It's more well to use a plastic opening tool to avoid damaging the cover.
- Mhen lifting the cover, be careful not to tear the Loudspeaker cable at the bottom right side.
- Disconnect the Loudspeaker cable from the Logic board.


Step 2






Before doing anything, disconnect the battery.

Step 3 — Audio Jack Connector







- Unscrew 2x Philips screws
- Disconnect and remove the Audio Jack Board flex cable.
- Remove the board with the Audio Jack Connector.
