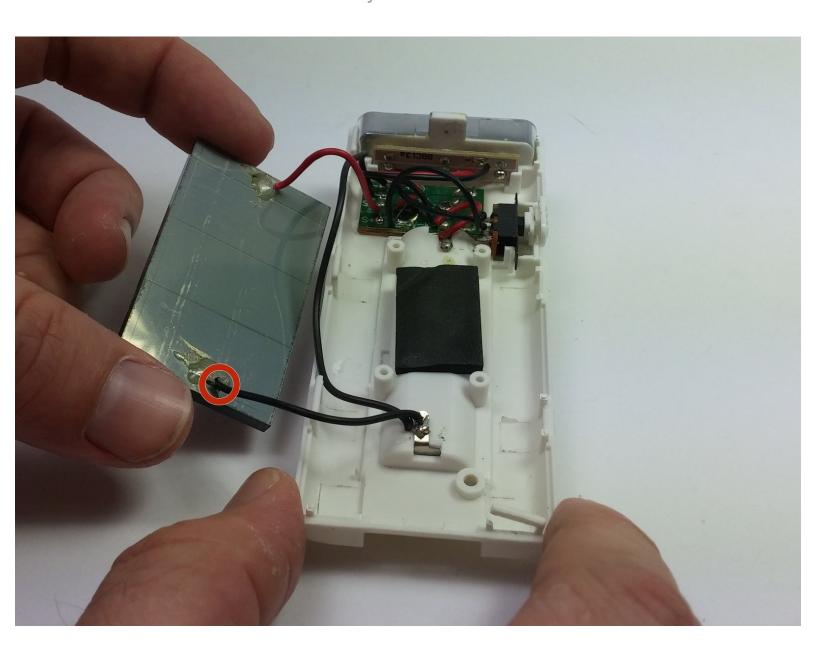


# **Nokero N400 Solar Panel Replacement**

Use this guide to replace the solar charger on your Nokero N400 solar flashlight.

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### **INTRODUCTION**

If your flashlight no longer charges its battery, it might be time to change your solar panel with this guide.

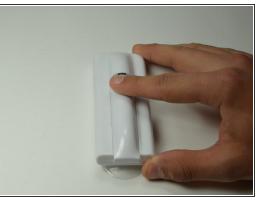


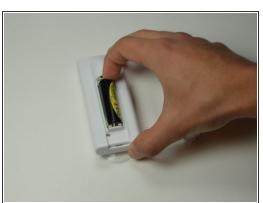
## **TOOLS:**

- Phillips #1 Screwdriver (1)
- iFixit Opening Tools (1)
- Flush Wire Cutters (1)

### **Step 1** — Remove Battery Cover







- Press down firmly to remove the battery cover and display battery.
- Then remove the battery.

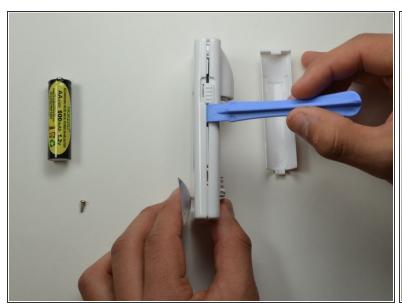
## **Step 2** — **Unscrew Back Cover**





Remove the 7mm Phillips #1 screw.

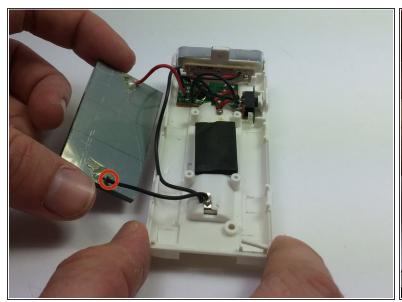
### Step 3 — Pry Open Back Cover

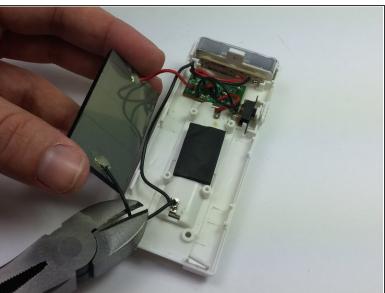




- Place the plastic opening tool in between the two plastic panels and slowly work your way around the device.
- Unlatch the clips on the inside and pull device apart.
- (i) Some clips will break when forced open.

#### Step 4 — Solar Panel





- Pull the panel away from the rest of the assembly and cut the red and black wires coming from the panel
- Be careful not to cut the ground-wire for the motherboard, it is the same color and goes to the exact same place as the solar panel wire.
- For reassembly you will need to either splice, or solder the wires onto the replacement.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
