INTRODUCTION


This is a simple guide to help users replace damaged or missing foam ear pads in their Xbox One Stereo Headset. The replacement should only take a couple of minutes, and only requires a metal spudger and a foam-safe, all purpose adhesive.



TOOLS:

- Metal Spudger (1)
- Super Glue (1)

Step 1 — Foam Ear Pads



Insert the metal spudger between the foam ear pad and the black plastic speaker cover.

Step 2



 Carefully slide the spudger between the ear pad and the speaker cover, along the seam, to remove the adhesive.

Step 3





- Be careful not to tear the cloth ear pad cover.
- Using your fingers, carefully pull the ear pad out from the black cloth cover.
- When reinserting the foam ear pad, you may want to use a foam-safe adhesive to secure the back side of the foam to the plastic speaker cover.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
