


How to clean your Roomba 4100's air filter.


INTRODUCTION

This guide will walk you through the steps to cleaning the Roomba air filter. A clean filter will improve performance and should be checked regularly.

TOOLS:


- Phillips #1 Screwdriver (1)
- iFixit Opening Tools (1)

Step 1 — How to clean your Roomba 4100's air filter.




 Slide out back bin by pressing the unmarked button on top of the Roomba.

Step 2




 Slide out yellow bar on particle bin to access filter

Step 3



• This is the air filter assembly

Step 4




 Pop out filter mount by prying 2 points that hold it to the rest of the assembly

Step 5



• Thoroughly clean or replace the air filter. This can be done with compressed air or by rinsing it with water.

Step 6



 Reassemble the air filter assembly and slide the particle bin back into place

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
