INTRODUCTION

Removing the battery is essential to the removal of other components on the Nintendo 3DS XL. Please remember to have the device powered off when following this guide.



TOOLS:

- JIS Driver Set (1)
- Tweezers (1)

ESD Safe

• iFixit Opening Tool (1)



PARTS:

- Nintendo 3DS XL (2012 or 2015) Battery
 (1)
- Nintendo 3DS XL (2015) Rear Panel (1)

Step 1 — Battery



- ♠ Ensure your device is powered off before proceeding. Failure to do so may result in electrical shock or damage to the device.
- Place the 3DS upside down.
 Remove the game card,
 headphones, charging cable, stylus,
 or anything else that may be
 connected to the device.

Step 2



- Using a JIS #0 screwdriver, loosen the two black screws on the back.
 - The screws are held in place by captive washers and should not be completely removed.

Step 3



 Once the screws are loosened, pry open the back cover.

Step 4



The battery is located on the left hand side of the 3DS - to remove, use the small gap located at the topmiddle and pull up with a non metal pointed tool.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
