### **INTRODUCTION**

# **TOOLS:**

- Allen Wrench (1)
- T20 Torx Screwdriver (1)


## Step 1 — Chuck





Using the T20 Torx Security screwdriver, take out the 2.3 mm screw inside the chuck.

### Step 2





- Set the drill to 'drill mode' and tighten the chuck with the Allen wrench in it.
- (i) 'Drill mode' is represented by the drill bit symbol
- Use the Allen wrench to unscrew the chuck by rotating it counter clockwise.

# Step 3



 Remove the chuck completely by unscrewing it in a counter clockwise direction.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
