INTRODUCTION

With the resurgence of vinyl records, it is important to know how to repair the vintage record covers that you may find in used record stores.

TOOLS:

Mod Podge (1)

Foam Brush (1)


Binder Clip (6)

Small

Microfiber Cleaning Cloth (1)

Paper Towels (1)

Step 1 — How to Repair Vintage Vinyl Record Covers



 These are the materials that are needed to complete this task.



 This is what a vintage vinyl record with seam splitting will look like at the beginning of our project.

Step 3



 Wet the top of the cover with a damp <u>microfiber cloth</u>.




• Apply the Mod Podge to the foam brush.

Step 5



• Apply the Mod Podge to the top of the cover.



 Press the cover together with your fingers, allowing excess glue to be pushed to the top of the cover.


Step 7



 Using a paper towel, wipe excess glue from cover.







- Apply three binder clips to top, and three binder clips to bottom of cover.
- Allow at least 30 minute to dry

Step 9



 This is what the finished product looks like.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
