INTRODUCTION

With the resurgence of vinyl records, it is important to know how to repair the vintage record covers that you may find in used record stores.

TOOLS:

[Mod Podge](#) (1)

[Foam Brush](#) (1)

[Binder Clip](#) (6)

Small

[Microfiber Cleaning Cloth](#) (1)

[Paper Towels](#) (1)

Step 1 — How to Repair Vintage Vinyl Record Covers



- These are the materials that are needed to complete this task.

Step 2



- This is what a vintage vinyl record with seam splitting will look like at the beginning of our project.

Step 3



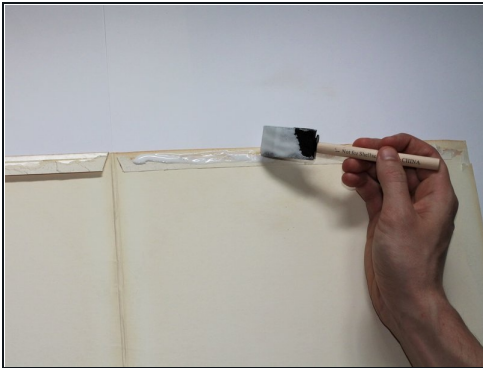
- Wet the top of the cover with a damp [microfiber cloth](#).

Step 4



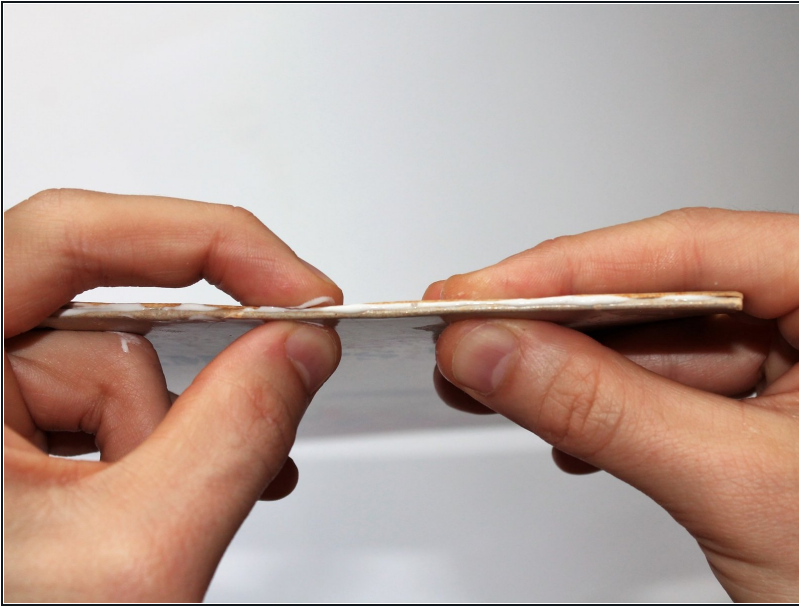
- Apply the Mod Podge to the foam brush.

Step 5



- Apply the Mod Podge to the top of the cover.

Step 6



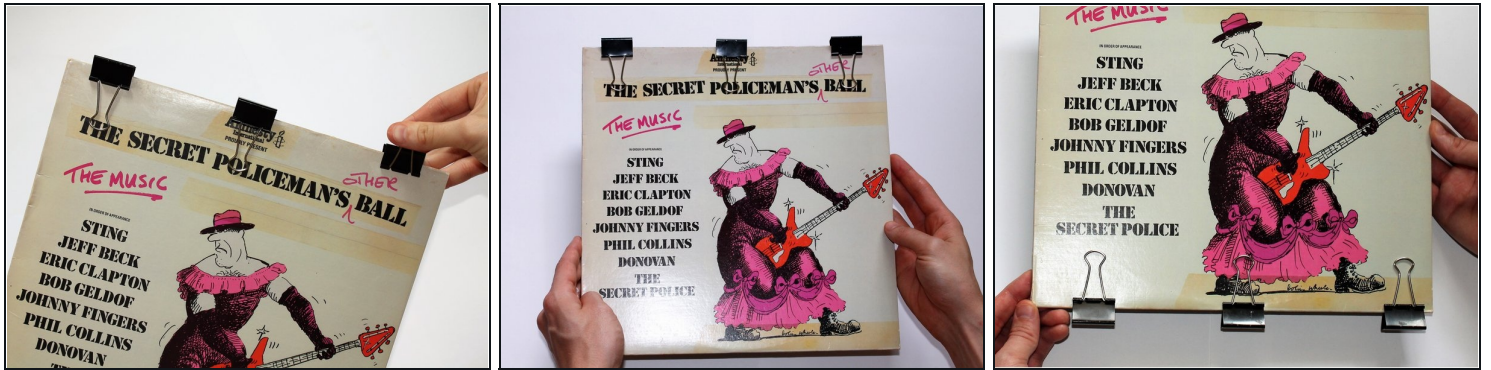
- Press the cover together with your fingers, allowing excess glue to be pushed to the top of the cover.

Step 7



- Using a paper towel, wipe excess glue from cover.

Step 8



- Apply three binder clips to top, and three binder clips to bottom of cover.
- Allow at least 30 minute to dry

Step 9



- This is what the finished product looks like.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
